"Amid growing concerns about network vulnerability, the demand for cyber security experts grew 73% during the five years from 2007 to 2012, according to Burning Glass. The demand for all 'computer' jobs grew 20%, and the demand for all jobs grew just 6%, according to the firm. **Compensation for cyber security experts, including engineers, analysts, managers, architects and others, averaged \$101,000, based on advertised salaries.** That was well above the compensation offered for the average IT job, which was about \$89,000, according to the report."
