- A letter of recommendation from one of the following: department chair, graduate advisor, faculty member, or another pertinent individual B. who has taught or advised the student. The letter should address the student's ability to complete the degree successfully and in a timely fashion.
- C. Unofficial copies of transcripts from colleges and universities attended by the student.

Continuing Tuition Fee Waiver Applicants: Once awarded, continuing graduate students are eligible to receive the tuition waiver through this program for up to three academic years. Awards for years two and three will require the following:

- A. Student must prepare a brief statement of their progress in the program (no more than 1 doubled-spaced typed page.)
- A letter of support from the relevant graduate program Chair or faculty advisor. This letter must address the student's progress in the B. program and plans for a timely graduation from the program.
- C. Unofficial copies of transcripts demonstrating satisfactory degree progress in the previous year (GPA of 3.0 or better, program progress)
