Course Planning and Time Management

- Full time student = Full time job
- 15 units (5 courses) = 40 hours (or more)/week
- Minimum course commitment = 40/5 = 8 hours/week
- Each course scheduled time:
 - Lecture only Scheduled for 3 hours/week
 - Lecture/Lab Scheduled for 5 hours/week
- Each course extra study time
 - 5 hours/week
